5 Key Takeaways from this session:

It is imperative to attend your child's 8th grade transition meeting to plan to high school.

#2

Transition planning and assessment should begin during middle school with interest inventories to determine your child's areas of interest for high school and post secondary outcomes.

Your child will start to be invited to IEP meetings at the age of 14. Allow them to attend in order to have valuable input into their educational plan.

8th grade transition meetings will determine the best course tract for your students, please make informed decisions.

Transition elements in the IEP will continue to evolve throughout your child's high school career, each transition outcome should be appropriate for the life of the IEP.
